In so far as is reasonably practicable, Fleury Engineering are committed to providing safe and healthy working conditions, equipment and systems of work for all employees for the prevention of work-related injury and ill health. The information, instruction and supervision needed for this purpose will be provided, but the co-operation of all staff is necessary to meet this goal. All employees and sub-contractors have the responsibility to co-operate with Management to achieve a healthy and safe workplace and to take reasonable care of themselves and others while working for or on behalf of the Company.

Workers have the ability to remove themselves from work situations that they consider present or imminent and to which there is serious danger to their life or health, as well as arrangements for protecting them from undue consequences for doing so.

Fleury Engineering considers that the proper discharge of the Health and Safety Policy is an important Management function. It looks to Management at all levels to ensure that best practice is followed to enable work to be carried out safely.
